Guardian Of the Quarter

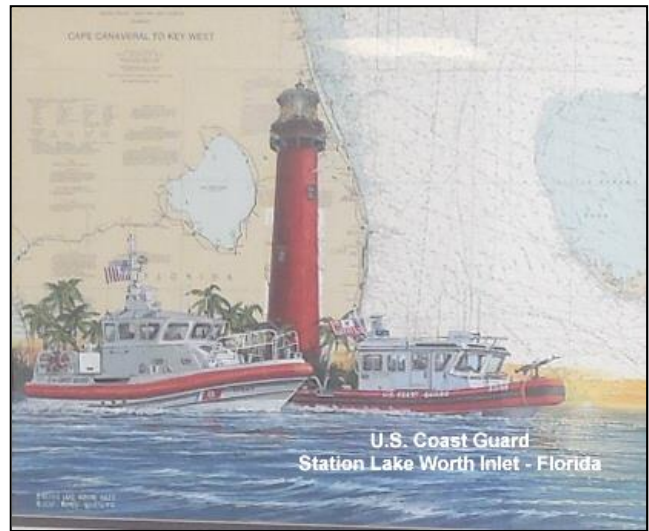
